# **Reception Update**

This term, our Reception children are off on an ocean adventure exploring underwater habitats and their inhabitants – both real and fictional.

We continue to consolidate our learning in phonics, reviewing both sounds and words to learn, in order to build confidence in reading and writing. As the children become more confident with their decoding, we can focus more on building fluency and comprehension skills. The children will be given lots of exciting opportunities to write in different styles to improve their writing stamina and develop their use of capital letters, full stops and interesting vocabulary.













In maths, we have extended our learning to 20 - writing, ordering and recognising composition of these numbers. We will also revisit the concepts of odd and even as well as double and half. In the afternoons, the children continue to select their own activities linked to our week's learning such as creating and testing boats and making junk-modelled underwater worlds!











We are starting our preparation for the Pirate Workshop at the end of week 4 (hosted at Webb's): creating flags, learning a new song and generating a class pirate name! The day will allow all the Reception children to come together in their very own pirate-themed parade before undertaking a number of pirate-themed activities. More information will be shared in a letter to parents.

It was a wonderful opportunity for us to be able to welcome you into our classrooms prior to the Easter break. We hope you enjoyed having the chance to see your children in their class settings and have a look through their books.
