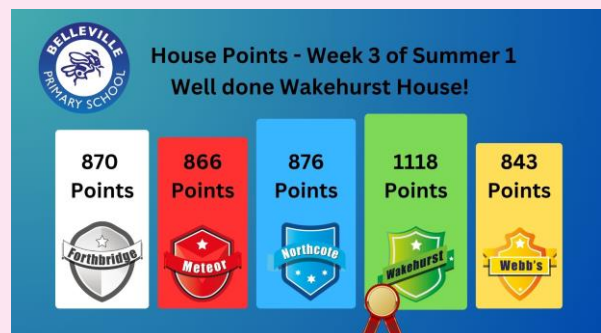

Year 1 Update

This term, our Reception children have set sail on an exciting ocean-themed adventure, exploring a variety of underwater habitats and the fascinating creatures that live within them - both real and imagined.

In phonics, we are continuing to build on prior learning by revisiting key sounds and words to learn, helping to strengthen the children's confidence in reading and writing. As the children become more secure in their decoding skills, we are placing a greater emphasis on developing fluency and understanding. They will also enjoy a wide range of engaging writing opportunities, designed to build stamina and a lifelong love for writing.



In maths, we are extending our work with numbers up to 20, focusing on writing, ordering, and understanding how these numbers are made. We will also revisit important concepts such as odd and even numbers, as well as doubling and halving. During the afternoons, children continue to explore activities linked to our weekly learning, including building pirate ships and creating their own imaginative underwater worlds using a variety of materials.

This week, we enjoyed a fantastic pirate day at Webb's Road. The children designed their own flags, learned and performed a new song, and came up with a class pirate name. The day brought all the Reception classes together for a lively pirate parade, followed by a range of fun, pirate-themed activities. We had a grand ol' time! Arrrr!
