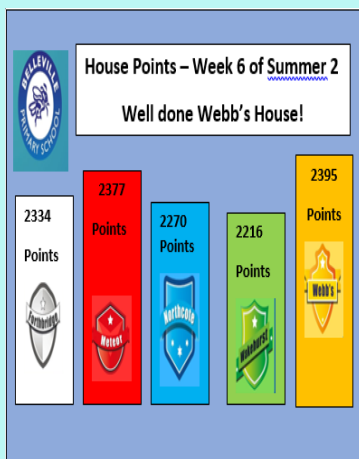

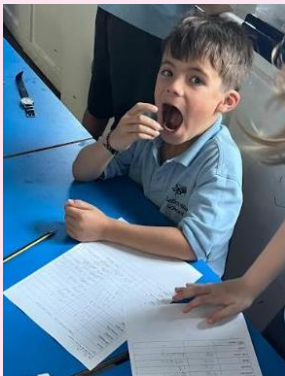
## Year 3 Update

We have had such a busy term in Year 3 and still have so much to look forward to in our final few weeks!

In English, we have read *The One and Only Ivan* and produced various writing outcomes. The children have grown very passionate about animal rights and written wonderful persuasive letters about how animals should be kept. We are now working on travel guides for Provence, which links to our geography learning as well.

Science has been incredibly exciting and we have loved exploring taste in our STEM unit.
