Dear Parents and Carers,

New Sports Surfaces

As part of our ambition to further develop the P.E. and sports facilities at Belleville Primary School, we are delighted to announce that due to the generous funding of <u>Belleville PTA</u> and the backing of the <u>Q1E Trust</u>, we will be resurfacing the largest playground at both Webb's Road and Meteor Street with a polymeric specialist sports surface during the school summer holidays. Work will commence on levelling the playground and laying the surface as soon as school breaks up for the summer holidays and the project is likely to take a week at Meteor Street and around 3 weeks at Webb's Road.

We have chosen a polymeric surface as it is incredibly versatile and can be used for many different sports. It has an impact absorbing surface, is low maintenance and suitable for all weather conditions, and is robust enough to allow both sites to continue with all their day-to-day activities and for the Webb's Road site to continue to host the larger scale events such as the Christmas and Summer Fairs.

Artist's impressions of the new surfaces are below. (Please note: the markings are not accurate for our pitches.)



Further information about fundraising will be shared by the PTA over the coming months. As you can imagine, this is a significant project for the PTA to fund and so their activities throughout next year (as well as this year) will be going towards funding this project too.

We hope that you are as excited about the opportunities that these new sports surfaces will offer your children as we are and that you will continue to support the PTA to help achieve our aim of improving and developing Belleville's P.E. and sports facilities.
