Children in Year 3 can enter the composer/period poster competition by creating a poster about one of the composers or periods of history they have explored this year in music. To enter, your child needs to collect a piece of A3 card (from the Music Room at Webb's/class teacher at Meteor) and decorate it as they choose – drawing, writing, painting, sticking on printed information.

Here is a list of composers & periods they have explored this term:

- Baroque: Johann Sebastian Bach, George Frideric Handel, Antonio Vivaldi.
- Classical: Joseph Haydn, Joseph Bologne, Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, Ludwig van Beethoven.
- Romantic: Clara Schumann, Fanny Mendelssohn, Samuel Coleridge-Taylor, Pyotr Ilyich Tchaikovsky, Amy Beach, Cécile Chaminade, Antonín Dvořák, Edward Elgar.
- 20th Century / Modern: Florence Price, Aaron Copland, Scott Joplin, Benjamin Britten.

The **closing date is Friday 6 June**. Posters can be given to Ms Hughes/School Office at Webb's, or to your class teacher/School Office at Meteor. The competition will be judged by Ms Hughes & Ms Green. All entrants will receive a small prize. Two winners will be chosen from each class and their posters will be displayed around the school sites. Posters must be submitted on the A3 card provided.
