There has been a lot of learning! In addition to SATS, Year 4 multiplication checks, and Year 1 Phonics Screening, our curriculum has been packed. The children's learning has been brought to life with visits to Black Cultural Archives, Hampton Court Palace, Holly Lodge, Horniman Museum, local science walks and the V&A Museum. We also had visitors into school including the Islamic Culture and Education Centre, author Magenta Fox, and Zoolab. Children represented Belleville at the French Bee finals at the University of Cambridge and were some of the first-ever child judges at the Chelsea Flower Show. Year 6 had some fantastic adventures on their PGL residential trip.



In sport, we've held sports days for all year groups, and our children have attended festivals and tournaments in cricket, football, netball and rugby.
