They were among 36 finalists from schools all over the UK. They both performed amazingly, with Ruby coming second overall! Bravo Ruby et Penelope!



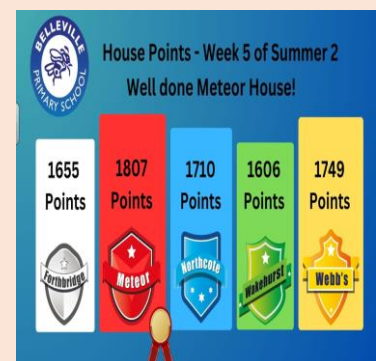
Chrome Books
